Figure 1: Typical Spectral Response

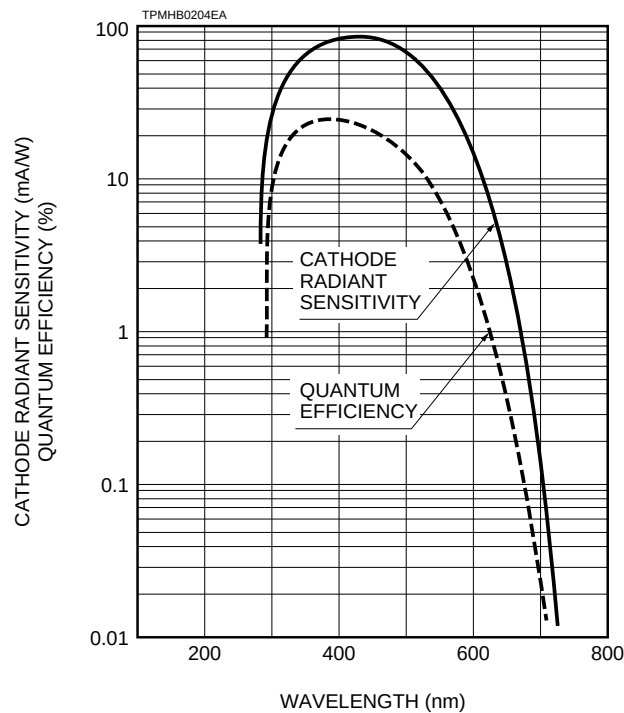
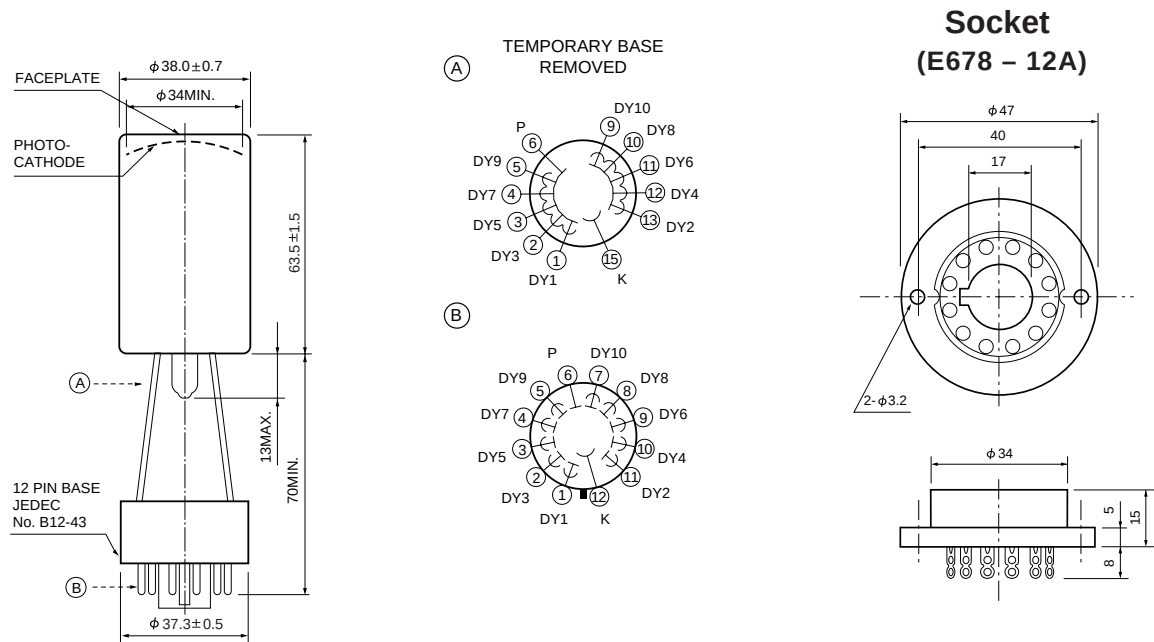


Figure 2: Dimensional Outline and Basing Diagram (Unit : mm)



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
