SPEED CLAMPS 132 & 133

SPEED CLAMPS ARE FASTER TO APPLY THAN A NORMAL BAR CLAMP BECAUSE THE BAR HAS SERRATIONS TOP AND BOTTOM THAT LOCK THE HEAD IN PLACE AS SOON AS ANY PRESSURE IS APPLIED.

ALTHOUGH THEY DO NOT HAVE THE SAME CLAMPING STRENGTH AS A SASH OR 'T' BAR CLAMP, THEIR SPEED OF ACTION

COMBINED WITH THE 120mm THROAT DEPTH, MAKE THEM THE MOST POPULAR TYPE OF BAR CLAMP ON THE MARKET.

FOR MEDIUM DUTY WORK CHOOSE THE 132.

FOR HEAVY DUTY WORK, THE 133.

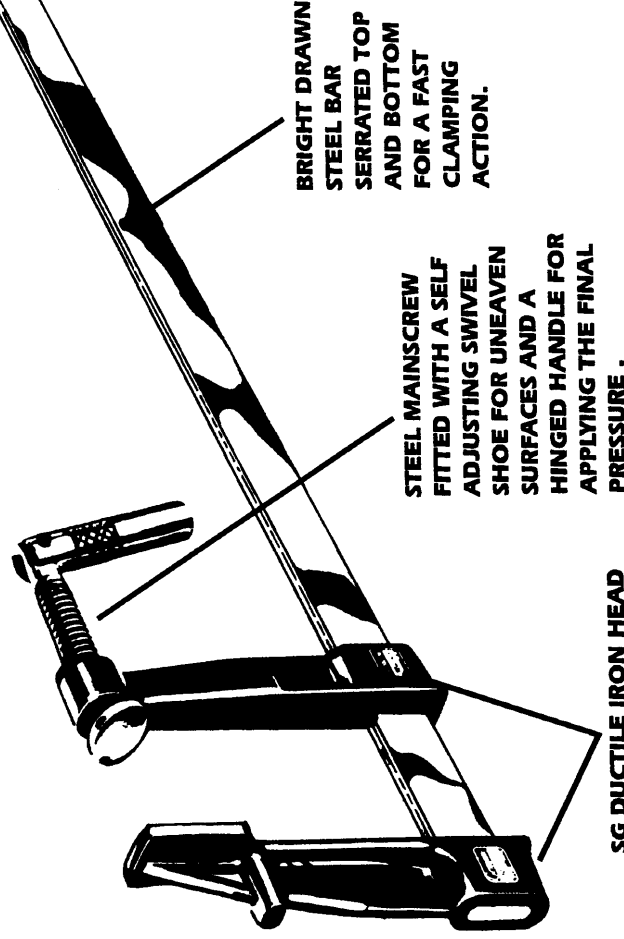
