



WAVELENGTH DEPENDENCE OF QUANTUM EFFICIENCY




TERMINAL CAPACITANCE vs. REVERSE VOLTAGE






DARK CURRENT AND PHOTO CURRENT vs. REVERSE VOLTAGE



Dark Current, ID, Iph (nA)




EXCESS NOISE FACTOR vs. MULTIPLICATION FACTOR






OUTLINE DIMENSIONS (Units in mm)


