
The HY63V8100A is a 1,048,576-bit high-speed, SRAM organized as 131,072 words by 8-bits. The HY63V8100A uses eight common input and output lines and has an output enable pin which operates faster than address access time at read cycle. The device is fabricated using Hyundai's advanced CMOS process and designed for high-speed circuit technology. It is particularly well suited for use in high-density high-speed system applications










READ CYCLE 1



Note (Read Cycle)



1. t_{CHZ} and t_{OHZ} are defined as the time at which the outputs achieve the open circuit conditions and are not referenced to output voltage levels.
2. At any given temperature and voltage condition, t_{CHZ} max. is less than t_{CLZ} min. both for a given device and from device to device.
3. /WE is high for read cycle.

READ CYCLE 2



Note (Read Cycle)

1. /WE is high for read cycle.
2. Device is continuously selected $/CS=V_{IL}$.
3. $/OE=V_{IL}$.

WRITE CYCLE 1(/OE Clocked)

WRITE CYCLE 2(/OE Low Fixed)

Notes(Write Cycle)

1. A write occurs during the overlap of a low /CS and a low /WE. A write begins at the latest transition among /CS going low, and /WE going low : A write ends at the earliest transition among /CS going high and /WE going high. tWP is measured from the beginning of write to the end of write.
2. tCW is measured from the later of /CS going low to end of write.
3. tAS is measured from the address valid to the beginning of write.
4. tWR is measured from the end of write to the address change. tWR applied in case a write ends as /CS or /WE going high.
5. If /OE and /WE are in the read mode during this period, the I/O pins are in the output low-Z state, inputs of opposite phase of the output must not be applied because bus contention can occur.
6. If /CS goes low simultaneously with /WE going low or after /WE going low, the outputs remain in high impedance state.
7. DOUT is the same phase of latest written data in the write cycle.
8. DOUT is the read data of the new address.




