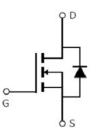

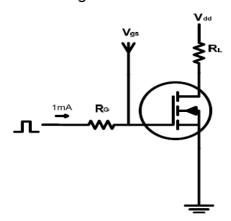


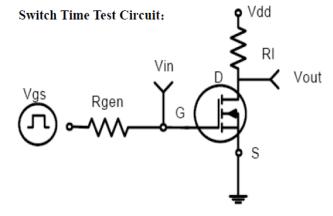

#### **EAS** test circuits:

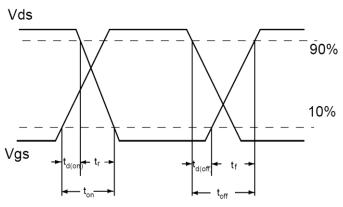


#### Gate charge test circuit:





#### **Switch Waveforms:**

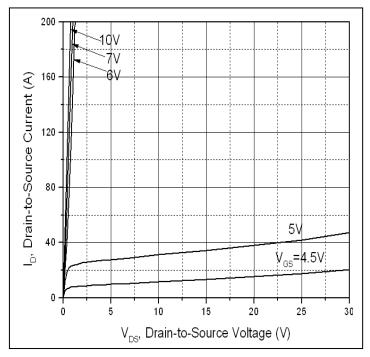

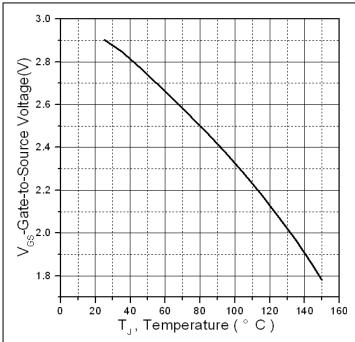


Figure 1: Typical Output Characteristics

Figure 2. Gate to source cut-off voltage

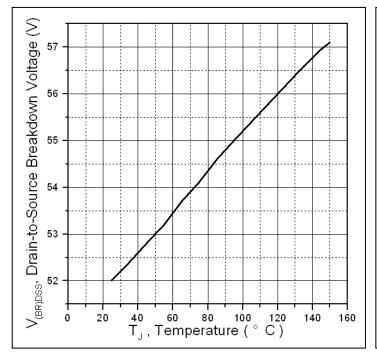


Figure 3. Drain-to-Source Breakdown Voltage vs. **Temperature** 

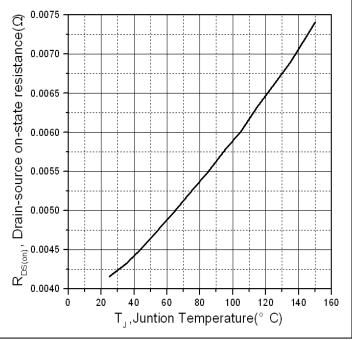
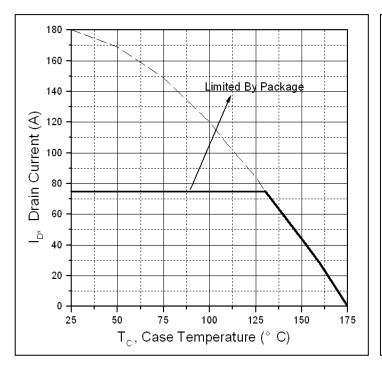


Figure 4: Normalized On-Resistance Vs. Case **Temperature**

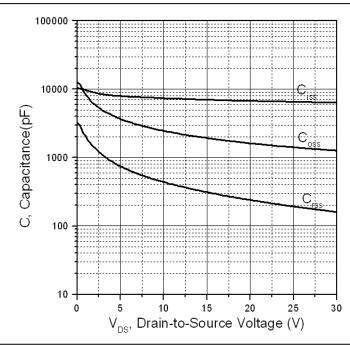


Figure 5. Maximum Drain Current Vs. Case Temperature

Figure 6.Typical Capacitance Vs. Drain-to-Source Voltage

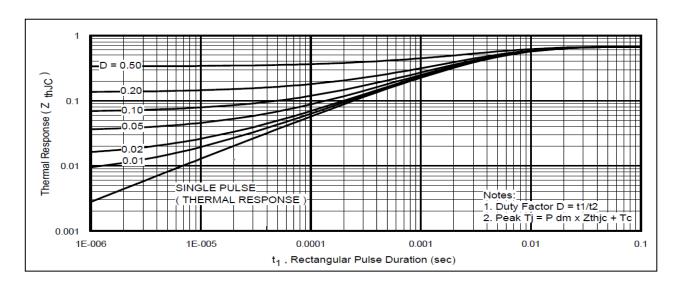
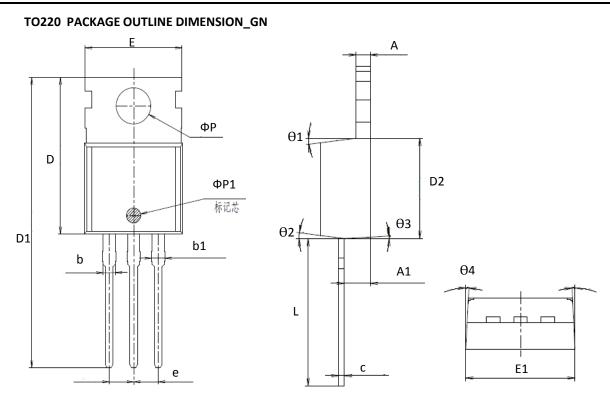


Figure 7. Maximum Effective Transient Thermal Impedance, Junction-to-Case
